WHEREAS, the transition of authority would be greatly facilitated by Mr. Thomas's involvement and participation in the administrative affairs of the School District until such time as he assumes the role of Interim Superintendent; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 3313.171 specifically authorizes the employment of consultants for matters relating to the administration of the School District; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Thomas has agreed to act as a Consultant to the Board to facilitate an effective transition until such time as he assumes his role as Interim Superintendent.

WHEREAS, the Board has authorized this Employment Contract to effectuate the employment of Mr. Thomas immediately in the capacity of Consultant to the Board of Education, and, as the Interim Superintendent as of August 1, 2024, or sooner in the event of a vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, it is mutually agreed by the parties to this Employment Contract.
